HONORING THE McCOY POTTERY COLLECTORS' SOCIETY FOR OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENT

On behalf of the members of the Senate of the 130th General Assembly of Ohio, we are pleased to extend special recognition to the McCoy Pottery Collectors' Society on the occasion of the dedication of an Ohio Historical Marker commemorating the Nelson McCoy Pottery Company, July 10, 2014.

The McCoy Pottery Collectors' Society is, indeed, deserving of praise for its efforts to gain this important distinction. Established by Nelson McCoy, Sr., as the Nelson McCoy Sanitary Stoneware Company in 1910, this fine endeavor produced utilitarian stoneware before shifting to decorative wares and adopting a new moniker, the Nelson McCoy Pottery Company, in 1933, and it became the nation's leading producer of artware pottery before ceasing operation in 1990. In securing an Ohio Historical Marker for the site, the members of the society have certainly distinguished themselves as conscientious and responsible citizens devoted to preserving our state's vibrant history.
